



I HAD A SCREENING MAMMOGRAM AND YOU CALLED ME BACK FOR ADDITIONAL VIEWS.

WHY?

While you are at the imaging center, the technologist checks your films for positioning and technique. However, when the radiologist later examines them, occasionally an area is seen that needs a further look. Our staff will call and schedule you for some additional views and/or a breast ultrasound to get more information about your breasts. This does not necessarily mean that you have breast cancer; many practices expect to call-back approximately 10% of their screening patients, yet less than 1% of a center's patients will typically be diagnosed with breast cancer. While it is normal for a person to worry, please keep in mind that the vast majority of women who are called back for more views will NOT have breast cancer.
